

SUPPORT: Current funding level of \$148 million for the National Endowment for the Arts (NEA) which brings the arts to every community in America.



#### FEDERAL INVESTMENT and IMPACT TO IDAHO

**\$787,000** Federal Funding to Idaho Commission on the Arts leverages \$1.5 million in state and local matching funds.

\$613,000 re-granted to 196 organizations \$149,000 in program services

Serving 665,988 Idahoans, 342,163 of whom are youth

**SUPPORT:** Current funding level of \$46.93 million for State Historic Preservation Offices (SHPOs) to carry out the requirements of the National Historic Preservation Act.



#### FEDERAL INVESTMENT and IMPACT TO IDAHO

**\$732,000** Federal Funding to SHPO annually leverages \$488,000 in state and local matching funds.

**\$75,000** re-granted to 17 city/county preservation districts for essential preservation projects.

### SHPO Federal responsibilities serves:

- 1,025 National Register of Historic Places listings in Idaho
- Over 1,500 federal projects reviews annually
- 3.000 Participants in cultural resource education
- 80,000 Active Historic Site Inventory records

SUPPORT: Current funding level of \$450 million for the Corporation for Public Broadcasting which ensures universal access to non-commercial, high-quality content and telecommunications.

#### FEDERAL INVESTMENT and IMPACT TO IDAHO

**\$1.5 Million** Federal Funding to IPTV leverages \$7.8 million in state and local matching funds.

- 98% of Idaho's population is reached by IPTV
- 460,000 Weekly views, per capita IPTV is the most regularly watched PBS station in America
- 200,000 Online learning resources for educators & students
- 4,000 people served through 31 public events

SUPPORT: Current funding level of \$148 million for the National Endowment for the Humanities (NEH) which provides crucial grants to organizations for research, education and preservation.
